
What Will I Find on My Child's EducationCity Page?

Each child will have a personalised page showing their name and the option to choose different avatars to express how they are feeling.




Classwork and Homework Tiles

For any additional learning, games, activities or videos, you will find these in the Subjects and Search Content areas.




Online Safety Tile


Games


Topic Tools

Practise segmenting and blending skills whilst looking at recognising real and nonsense words - a key skill for phonics!




Synonyms and Antonyms (Content ID: 42747)

For children in the upper end of the school, being able to use a thesaurus and recall synonyms and antonyms for a word is key when looking at advancing their writing. This tool supports those areas and is a great help for creative writing.


Time (Content ID: 41768)

Telling the time is always going to be a foundational skill, so use this tool to help with learning and if your children can already tell the time, change the settings to a dual clock view and look at calculating the time difference.



Multiplication Tool (Content ID: 42773)

Whether looking at mental or formal written methods, this tool is an excellent way of practising times tables at home.



Seasons (Content ID: 42755)



Projects and Investigations

These are great to keep your children occupied and a fantastic way of showing their teachers independent learning. Have a look at the EducationCity subject area to find out what units your child or children are learning and set them off! Some fun suggestions are:




Odds and Evens, Doubles and Halves

Grab a bunch of socks and ask your child to count how many there are. Maybe make a note on some paper to practise writing numbers. Then ask them to pair the socks together. You can then count how many pairs for halves and doubles there are and see any leftover socks. This will tell you whether the original number was odd or even! The 'Odds and Evens' Games will help with practising numbers and dividing.



Create a Character

Why not encourage your child to create a character of their choice? This could link with a favourite game, television show or be a creation of their imagination. You can work on describing that character, from identifying their appearance, to writing a full description. Children can then place their character into a setting, story, comic book or game of their creation.



Learning Science and Asking Questions

Start asking questions so that you can work out answers for yourself. This can be as simple as asking, 'why do we wear woolly things in winter?' 'What minibeasts live in our garden?' 'What happens to shadows throughout the day?' You'll find some great investigation starters in our ThinkIts.
